
Master student position!



Project NCN: "Parents-offspring vocal interactions in a long-lived Arctic seabird, the little auk Alle alle"

As part of the project, the possibility of completing a master's thesis (or an additional research project). Master's thesis to be carried out in 2024/2025, with the implementation of the main tasks in the period: from 1 June to 1 December 2024. For the period of implementation of the main tasks (June-December) - stipend of 2000 pln/month.

Formal requirements: The applicant must be studying at a Polish university (final year of undergraduate studies or first or second year of graduate studies in biology or a related field).

Additional assets: For the main tasks: knowledge of basic techniques for the analysis of audio-visual material; conscientiousness and attentiveness; experience in laboratory work may also be an asset; in addition (if for a master's thesis), knowledge of English, knowledge of statistical programmes (including programming skills, preferably in R), and at least a willingness to learn and an ability to seek solutions to analytical problems.

Tasks description (main: to be carried out within 6 months): analysis of video material and sound recordings, in addition (if a master's thesis is carried out on this basis) working with data and writing the thesis.

Additional information: The fellowship will be awarded in accordance with the Regulations for the award of research fellowships in research projects funded by the National Science Centre.
